Important Information for Participants of the Silver Skate Spring Cup 2025!

We are pleased to announce that as part of the Silver Skate 2025 competition, the final of the Lithuanian Grand Prix will take place. Therefore, all participants of the Silver Skate Spring Cup 2025 will be awarded, and there will also be a separate awards ceremony for the Lithuanian participants of the Grand Prix.

Get ready for unforgettable moments, athletic achievements, and awards!

GENERAL

Silver Skate Spring Cup 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications. Participation in Silver Skate Spring Cup 2025 is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication. In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification. All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation. Clubs registered at ISU Members Federations can participate in competition or Invited clubs ONLY. The OC can have a final design about over quota for any club/country/federation or refuse to accept the entry (full or partially). Men and Women: ISU and NON ISU

ENTRIES

All the members of ISU and Clubs, being members of the National Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part in this competition. Members can enter any quantity of Skaters into each category.

Organizers have the right to refuse or limit participation in competition. All Entries must be done through Sportity Online Registration System: <https://fs.sportity.com> . Any Clubs entering first time should contact Sportity OÜ for account creation (info@sportity.com). **Note!!! that possible waiting for password from Sportity could be +/- 3 days!!!**

It is not allowed to change the skaters category after the deadline and after entries are published. You can replace one skater with another only in the same category. You can make changes in the same category not later than 1 day before draw.

All entries are expected not later than **March 15th, 2025**. However, due to a limited number of available spots, we highly recommend submitting your entry by **March 10th, 2025** to secure your place.

Entry fee per competitor is **80 EUR – one program, 95 EUR – two programs**. Entry fee for **elements – 55 EUR**. Entry fee can be paid in cash at arrival or by bank transfer.

Entry fees must be paid after confirmation of member participation. **Bill must be paid with one (1) transaction for all the country/member participants.**

The entry fee will not be refunded after the deadline in case of withdrawals for any reason. The Organizer will not return entry fee but you can replace one skater for some category not later than one week before draw. The entry fees have to be transferred to the following bank account:

MUSIC

All competitors shall furnish by **March 20th, 2025** competition music of excellent quality via email to **hello@silverskate.lt**. The music files must be sent as MP3, M4A or WAV format. Any other format is not acceptable. In accordance with Rule 343 paragraph 2. must have Competitor`s name, Member`s name and the exact running time of the Music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration.

Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) in the format of a MP3, M4A or WAV format.

If music information is not complete and music not provided, accreditation will not be given.

DRAW

There will be an electronic Draw for all categories. The Starting Orders after the Draw will be available at the competition website www.silverskate.lt and Sportity application.

TIMESCHELUDE

Detailed time schedule be available at the competition website www.silverskate.lt and Sportity application soon after the close of entries

RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used. Result information and detailed protocols will be available on the website www.silverskate.lt and Sportity application.

AWARDS

All the Competitors in each category will be announced and honored during the awarding ceremony in hall. The first three best placed Competitors in each category will be awarded with trophies. Diplomas and souvenirs will be provided for all participants. The Award Ceremonies will be published with the official Time Schedule.
